ITEM 5. BRIEF RESUME OF DUTY ASSIGNMENTS: AUS

Upon graduation from OCS I served as a motor officer, platoon leader, and battery executive officer in Btry A, 27 Bn, 7 Regt Ft Sill, from Feb 43 thru Apr 44. Joined the 655 FA Bn, 8"How as XO of Btry C upon activation at Cp Hood, Tex, and then on to the Pacific to combat in the Phillipines - Leyte, Mindanao, and Luzon. Also served as Btry Commander in combat and Bn S3. Transferred to the ORC in Jul 46.

From Dec 47 to ~~XXX~~ 60 I served in the 107th Engr Bn, Mich Army National Guard as a Company Commander for 2½ years; Bn S2 for 1 year; Bn S4 for 7½ years; and Bn S3 for 2 years. I was next assigned as XO, 46 Inf Div Spt Command for 5 years.
