COLONEL GERARD P. BARRETT

Colonel Jerry Barrett was drafted into the Army in 1966. He was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the Field Artillery upon completion of Officer Candidate School in 1967. He holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History from Cameron University, Lawton Oklahoma, a Master of Education Degree in human services from Boston University, and a Master of Science Degree in acquisition management from Florida Institute of Technology. He is a graduate of the Defense Systems Management College, the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, the Army Organizational Effectiveness Staff Officer Course, and the Field Artillery Officer Basic and Advance Courses. Prior to assuming his current position, Colonel Barrett has served in a variety of acquisition and Field Artillery assignments. From 1985-1991, he was assigned to the Army Tactical Missile System <Army TACMS> Project Office, serving initially as an Assistant Project Manager, and then as the Product Manager for Smart Submunition Warhead Development, managing demonstration/validation of the Infrared Terminally Guided Submunition <IRTGSM>.
