General Ice began his military career when he enlisted in the Kentucky Army National Guard on 6 January 1964. He received his commission as Second Lieutenant upon completion of the Field Artillery Officer Candidate Course on 18 September 1966. His first assignment was as Assistance Executive Officer in Battery C, 2-138th FA until April 1968 when he moved to the Exec Officer position of Battery C and was subsequently ordered to Active Duty with the 2-138th FA for service in Vietnam on 22 April 1968. He served as Executive Officer of Battery C at Fort Hood Texas and in Vietnam until March 1969 when he moved to Recon and Survey Officer position in Hqs Battery 2/138th FA. He remained there until Oct 69 when the battalion reformed in Vietnam for return home and was assigned back to the Exec Officer position in Battery C for the transition and release from Active Duty on 20 October 1969. Following his release from Active Duty, he was transferred to HQs 2-138th FA where he served as Liaison Officer, Assistant S-3 before returning again, in Oct 71, to Battery C as Btry Commander. In June of 1973 he moved back to Bn HQs and subsequently served as Bn Asst S-3, XXIII Corps Arty, Asst S-3, C/A Liaison, S-3 of the 2-138th and on 4 Nov 80, became Commander of the 2-138th FA. He remained there for four years before moving to the State Staff as Chief, Tng Division, STARC. He went back to the Field Artillery in Oct 84 as the Executive Officer 138th FA Bde, serving in this position until March 1987 when he assumed command of the 138th FA Bde, remaining in that position until Jul 89. On 1 August 1989, he was assigned to HQS STARC as the Deputy Adjutant General and in Aug 90 assigned as the Assistant Deputy Division Commander, 35th Inf Div where he remained until his retirement on 30 June 1992.
