## Colonel John William Lundberg Jr. (Class 3-41)

Colonel Lundberg earned an LLB degree from the University of Minnesota in 1938. He enlisted in the Army and was called to active duty on February 19, 1941. He was commissioned a Second Lieutenant upon completion of the Field Artillery Officer Candidate School, Fort Sill, Oklahoma on December 19, 1941.

His initial assignment was to Battery C, 39th Field Artillery Battalion, Fort Lewis, Washington. He fought in World War II with the 99th Infantry Division in the European Theater of Operation and was promoted to Major on December 1, 1944. He became a Regular Army career officer in 1946.

Colonel Lundberg had a combat tour in Korea with the 3rd Infantry Division. He was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel on July 7, 1951 and completed the Command and General Staff College in 1952. He served two tours in the Pentagon and was promoted to Colonel on January 24, 1962. He graduated from the U.S. Army War College in 1963.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star.
