5. Brief resume of duty assignments:  
Commissioned in the field artillery after graduation from OCS at Fort Sill in 1942. During World War II served overseas with the 609th Tank Destroyer Battalion and Combat Command A, 10th Armored Division as a tank destroyer and a tank company commander. In 1948, transferred to Armor. Subsequently, commanded a tank company in the 7th Division in Korea. In 1957, took command of the 1st Battalion, 35th Armor, 4th Armored Division at Fort Hood and gyroscoped with that unit to Europe. In 1959, became division G3. Graduated from the Armed Forces Staff College in 1961, served in the Operations and Training Division of DCSOPS, DA, and later with the Joint Chiefs of Staff as an operations officer in J3. Following graduation from the National War College in 1966, commanded a brigade of the 2d Infantry Division in Korea.
