Sep65-Jun67 initiated USA Security Agency/US Naval Security Group Operations Officer Exchange Program as Head, COMINT and Tech Spt Br, Spec Opns Dpt, provided operations orders and evaluations for seaborne COMINT platforms (USS Liberty & Pueblo).
