Civilian Occupations:

Current – Manager, Business Office, VA Medical Center, Lebanon, PA. Responsibilities include supervision of business and administrative support operations of a 300 bed general medical and surgical medical center. Manages a department of 55 professional, technical and administrative personnel, including accounts receivable, admissions, registration, medical records, transcription, travel, accounts payable, patient administration, patient funds, and other sundry functions.

1997-1999 – Manager, information Management. Supervised a staff of 35 professional, technical and administrative personnel in 6 separate section, including the Chief Information Officer, Chief Technical Officer, Medical Center Education, Library/Learning Resources, telecommunications, mail and distribution. Responsibility for planning, coordinating and executing the medical center Y2K transition program, which involved over one million dollars in expenditures and required assessment, renovation, updating or replacement of thousands of items of information technology, communication, medical and facility equipment, software and systems, as well as developing a comprehensive contingency plan in the event of system failures.

1973-1997 – Human Resources Director for several VA medical centers ranging from 300 to 1000 beds. Included responsibility for development and operation of the complete human resource program including staffing, compensation, employee relations, labor relations, staff development and training, resource allocation, equal employment opportunity, organizational development, manpower planning, etc.
