
Killed in a jeep accident traveling to Camp Gruber, Oklahoma while serving with Headquarters VIII Corps Artillery, 3rd U.S. Army.

Officer Is Killed When Jeep Hits Tree Near Caney

Two traffic casualties, both of them attributed to rains that drenched Oklahoma Wednesday, were reported by the state highway patrol Wednesday night.

Lieut. Charles L. Babcock, 28. Camp Bowie. Texas, was killed instantly Wednesday afternoon when his jeep crashed into a tree and overturned four miles south of Caney on US highway 69 in Atoka county. Buck Cook, trooper who investigated the accident, said Lieut. Babcock suffered a compound skull fracture.

With him was S/Sgt. George Harris, who was taken to Perrine field, Texas, for treatment of a back injury and shock. The two were with a group of soldiers being transferred to Camp Gruber.
