

Major General (Ret) Craig Bambrough Class 35A-67

MG Bambrough retired from active duty in June 2002 after 35 years of service. He began his Army career as an enlisted soldier in 1966. After completing Combat Engineer training at Fort Leonard Wood, he attended Artillery OCS at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and was commissioned in the Field Artillery in September 1967.

After commissioning, General Bambrough volunteered for duty in Viet Nam and in February 1968 was assigned to the 7/11FA, 25th Infantry Division in Tay Ninh, South Vietnam. Over the next 18 months he served in successive assignments as Forward Observer for C Company 4/23rd & C Company 1/5th Mechanized Infantry, Fire Direction Officer (FDO) for C Battery 7/11th FA and Brigade Artillery Liaison Officer (LNO) for the 1st Brigade, 25th Infantry Division.

Upon returning to the United States in October 1969, General Bambrough returned to school and earned his BS degree from University of California–Berkeley in the spring of 1974. While attending UC Berkeley, General Bambrough joined Army Reserve and held a variety of assignments completing his military career as the Deputy Commanding General of the United States Army Reserve Command (USARC) and the Deputy Commanding General United States Army Forces Command (FORSCOM in June 2002.

General Bambrough currently works for Accenture Federal Services located in Arlington, Virginia as a Managing Director, where he supports multiple Army, Navy, Joint and Intelligence clients providing a variety of management consulting services.

General Bambrough's awards and decorations include the Distinguish Service Medal, Silver Star (w/1 OLC), Legion of Merit, Bronze Star with "V" Device (w/2 OLC), Purple Heart (w/1 OLC), Meritorious Service Medal (w/2 OLC), Air Medal, Army Commendation Medal with "V" Device (w/1 OLC), Army Achievement Medal and Combat Infantryman Badge.

General Bambrough currently resides in South Riding, Virginia with his wife of 40 years Susan. They have two daughters, Kendall and Morgan who live in Raleigh, NC and Sacramento, CA respectively. He enjoys fly fishing and spending time with his family spoiling his three grandchildren, Kelley, Cosmo and Reagan Rose.
