Lieutenant Barmann was reported killed in action in France December 13, 1944. A field artillery man in the 7th army, Lieutenant Barmann had been overseas since October, 1943. He had taken part in three major engagements in Italy, France and Germany and received three stars.

A graduate of Emmerich Manual Training High School, he was employed by The Indianapolis News for several years and by the National Cash Register Company, Indianapolis service department, for four years before his enlistment in October, 1941. He attended officers candidate school, Ft. Sill, Oklahoma, and was commissioned a second lieutenant April 22, 1943.
