I AM PLEASED TO NOMINATE RETIRED COLONEL ROGER BARNHART TO THE OCS HALL OF FAME. COLONEL BARNHART WAS GRADUATED FROM FORT SILL AS A SECOND LIEUTENANT IN 1952, CLASS 16-52.

AFTER SERVICE IN KOREA, COLONEL BARNHART SERVED IN THE NATIONAL GUARD, DURING WHICH TIME, HE EARNED HIS DEGREE AS DOCTOR OF MEDICINE. RETURNING TO ACTIVE DUTY, COLONEL BARNHART SERVED IN VARIOUS CAPACITIES AND IN 1969 TRANSFERRED TO THE ACTIVE RESERVE.

SINCE THEN HE HAD HIS OWN MEDICAL PRACTICE, FROM WHICH HE RETIRED IN 1994. DURING HIS MEDICAL PRACTICE AND DURING HIS PRESENT RETIREMENT COLONEL BARNHART HAS BEEN ACTIVE IN MANY SOCIAL AREAS INCLUDING LECTURES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PAPUA IN NEW GUINEA AND VOLUNTEER WORK WITH HIGH RISK CHILDREN AT THE LOCAL PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.

THIS NOMINATION OF COLONEL BARNHART IS NOT ONLY BASED ON HIS ACHIEVING THE RANK OF COLONEL, BUT ALSO HIS OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE MEDICAL PROFESSION IN NEW GUINEA AND TO THE SOCIAL WELFARE OF CHILDREN IN THE BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.
