Colonel Del Reed Bergeson (Class 55-54)

Colonel Bergeson enlisted in the Army in 1953 and attended the Artillery Officer Candidate School, Fort Sill, Oklahoma. He was commissioned a 2LT on August 10, 1954.

He was a graduate of the Artillery Advance Course and was rated as an Army Aviator in 1958. He attended the Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas in 1968. He received his degree in Political Science at Utah State University in 1972.
