Colonel Bonesteel's initial assignment after graduating from Officer Candidate School at Fort Sill was an instructor and later Basic Training Headquarters Company Commander at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He then left active duty to pursue a career in the U.S. Army Reserve.

He was the Executive Officer and later Commander of Battery A, 3rd Battalion, 75th Field Artillery prior to serving four years as an Instructor at the 4152nd USAR School in New Orleans, Louisiana. His next assignment was Air Drops Plans Officer with the 377th Support Command in New Orleans, followed by duty as Civilian Supply Officer for the 308th Civil Affairs Group in Homewood, Illinois.

Subsequent assignments of increasing responsibility included Fire Support Coordinator, Field Artillery Battalion and finally Field Artillery Group Director for the 75th Maneuver Area Command (MAC) in Houston Texas. His military career culminated as Deputy Commander, 1st Brigade, 75th Division.

Since 2005 he has been with ITT Technical Institute. He first served as the Director of Houston North where he was named Director of the Year of the 100 schools for 2008. In February 2009 he became South Central District Manager responsible for 12 schools serving 5,200 students and more than 700 employees.

Colonel Bonesteel's decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal and the Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster.
