I was in 4th Platoon and helped drag Capt. Boyev's body to our perimeter. I remember placing a green o.d. towel over his face as we waited for the Medevac. Peter died as the result of being shot in the head during a fire fight. He did not suffer. One other was killed in that fire fight (Manuel Torres from Phoenix) and a bunch were wounded. I didn't know the Captain well but he seemed like a good officer and man. Things got worse for C Company and by June we had suffered 19 KIA's and double that wounded. Dark Days.
