## City Pilot Killed In Airplane Crash

Lieut. Guy R. Brown, who was attached to the 730th field artillery battalion at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., was killed Wednesday in an airplane crash, his wife, Mrs. Margaret Brown, 3016 Venice, was notified.

Lieutenant Brown was stationed in the Oklahoma City induction station until July 1942. He received his commission December 17 and his wings as liaison pilot in March. Since then he had been at Fort Leonard Wood. Services and burial will be in Marshall, Ark.
