CAPTAIN PAUL DU REE CALDWELL (*General Offices*) was Battalion Operations Officer for the 41st Field Artillery Bn. of the 3rd Infantry Division at Anzio, the Liberation of Rome, and the 7th Army's invasion of Southern France. He was killed November 20, 1944 in the advance through France and was buried at Epinal. Capt. Caldwell was decorated with the Silver Star, Bronze Star, Croix de Guerre with Gold Star, and Purple Heart.

(Citation Needed): Paul D. Caldwell, United States Army, is reported to have been awarded the Silver Star for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity in action against the enemy while serving with the 3rd Infantry Division during World War II.
