

Colonel John Alfred Carter (Class 19-52)

Colonel Carter enlisted in the Army on August 8, 1951 and graduated from the Artillery Officer Candidate School at Fort Sill, Oklahoma on July 15, 1952. He served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army Reserves with three years in the National Guard (1955-1957) until retiring on April 15, 1990. His last assignment was Commander of the 40th Ordnance Group, USAR Jackson, Mississippi.



Colonel Carter was nominated for the Artillery OCS Hall of Fame by a classmate on behalf of his widow in 1997. Complete information on his assignments during his military career was never received from the National Personnel Records Center. Copies of two documents are provided here to substantiate that he attained the rank of Colonel in the AUS (Army of the United States).


PURPOSES: 1. To provide his widow and children with information which was not in John's personal file.
