**KIRKWOOD ARMY MAN KILLED
IN PLANE FLIGHT IN COLORADO**

Second Lt. Alexander Crow Jr. was killed last night in an airplane crash near Camp Carson, Colo., his parents, who reside at 414 Dickson avenue, Kirkwood, were notified by Army authorities. Lt. Crow and the pilot of the plane were making a routine training flight when their plane crashed, killing both outright.

Lt. Crow, a graduate of Kirkwood High School, attended the University of Missouri for three years before enlisting in the Army two years ago. He was 23 years old. A field artillery liaison officer, he was commissioned at Fort Sill, Ok. Besides his parents, he is survived by a brother, Hadlond Dale Crow.
