7. GENERAL REMARKS: SAW COMBAT WITH 1ST INF. DIV. NORMANDY. UPON ACTIVATION THIRD ARMY SERVED WITH 5TH INFANTRY DIVISION ARTILLERY. IN LA.N.G. CAPACITY OF DEPUTY ADJ. GENERAL-ARMY WAS SERVING IN BRIGADIER GENERAL SLOT. WAS FORCED TO RESIGN BECAUSE OF PERMANENT CHANGE OF ADDRESS IN CIVILIAN OCCUPATION PRIOR TO BECOMING ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL RECOGNITION. WAS GIVEN STATE COMMISSION LA.N.G. AS BRIGADIER GENERAL.
