

COLONEL HAROLD O. DAVIS CLASS 46-43

Colonel Davis attended Liaison Pilot training after graduating from Officer Candidate School. He then served with the 123rd Field Artillery Battalion, 33rd Infantry Division in the Asian Pacific Theatre in World War II flying missions as a liaison pilot. After the War he returned to Fort Sill for duty as an instructor with the Department of Air Training and the 18th Field Artillery Battalion.

He served with the 3rd Infantry Division Artillery in Japan and later in the Korean War with the 39th Field Artillery Battalion, After the Korean War he again returned to Fort Sill for the Advanced Course and an assignment to the Gunnery Department. He later attended the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, and the Armed Forces Staff College. He then commanded the 3rd Battalion, 3rd Artillery at Fort Knox and culminated his career with an assignment to the Defense Intelligence Agency in Washington, D.C.

Colonel Davis' decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star with Oak Leaf Cluster, Air Medal, Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, American Campaign Medal, Asian Pacific Campaign Medal, World War II Victory Medal, Army of Occupation Medal, Korean Service Medal and the United Nations Korean Service Medal.
