

COLONEL THOMAS R. DAVIS CLASS 13-69

Colonel Davis was initially assigned as an Instructor in the NCO Combat Leaderships Course prior to serving in Vietnam as Division Signal Supply Officer, 426th Supply and Services Battalion, 101st^t Airborne Division.

After release from active duty, he was assigned to the 103rd USAR Support Brigade where he served as Assistant Supply Requirements Officer, Air Drop Plans Officer and Supply Plans-Policy Officer. He later served as Chief, Property Processing Disposal Branch and Material Management Officer for the 103rd Corps Support Command, Des Moines Iowa. His subsequent assignments with the 56th Material Management Center at Fort Snelling, Minnesota included Material Information Systems Officer, Material Systems Analyst, Chief, Electronics Division, Material Supply and Material Control Officer.

He then commanded the 457th Transportation Battalion followed by duty as the Chief, Supply and Services Division, Deputy Chief of Staff, 88th Army Reserve Command at Fort Snelling. After commanding the 6th Material Management Center, 19th Theater Army Area Command, he served as Deputy Commander, 19th Theater Army Area Command. He culminated his career as Chief of Staff, 19th Theater Support Command.

Colonel Davis' decorations include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal w/2 OLC, Army and Commendation Medal w/2 OLC.
