1LT Dunbar was assigned to Battery C, 6th Battalion, 11th Artillery, Americal Division. He was killed in action while serving as a Forward Observer with Company B, 1st Battalion, 20th Infantry. His decorations include the Silver Star for gallantry in action.

From the 6th Battalion, 11th Artillery Duty Log:

At 1740hrs at 761375 Bravo Company (-) 1-20 Infantry is hit by small arms fire with results of 1 US KHA and 4 US WIA (E). SGT JOSEPH VIINCENT SCHMIDT Bravo Company and 1LT ROY WILLIAMS DUNBAR of Charlie Battery 6-11 Artillery is LISTED AS KHA. Bravo Company 1LT David M. Hunt was evac.
