

Colonel Richard M. Dunne (Class 13-70)

Colonel Richard M. Dunne was commissioned a Second Lieutenant upon graduation from Artillery Officer Candidate School Class 13-70 on June 12, 1970. He began his officer career as a forward observer at Fort Riley. He served in Vietnam with the 1st Cavalry Division and later as a detachment and company commander with the 70th Division in Flint, Michigan. He has held numerous positions with the Active Guard and Reserve.

Colonel Dunne had the opportunity to work in Washington with the development of the Counter Drug Policy for the Department of the Army and with the Undersecretary for Army Internal Affairs in the integration of the reserve forces. He served as the Senior Army Reserve Advisor for the 5th Army.

His decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters.
