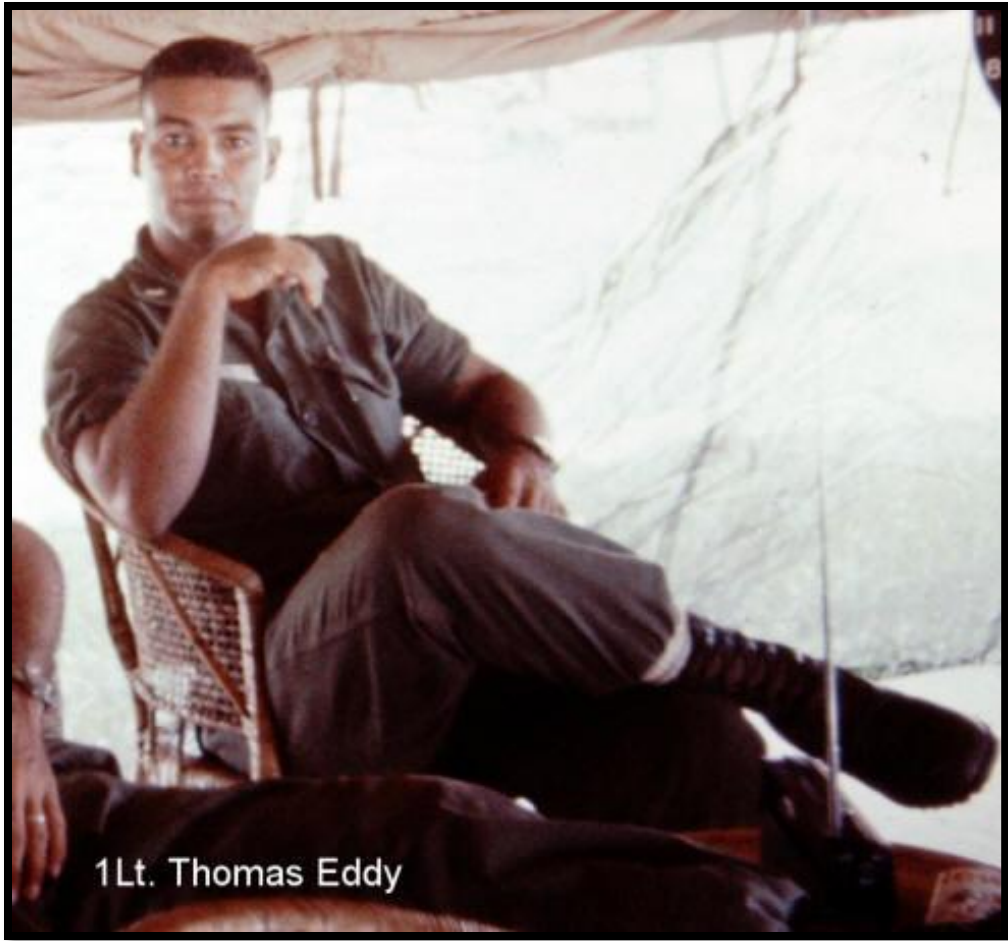
CPT Eddy died on June 26, 1966 near Phouc Vinh when he was accidentally shot by another soldier while returning from a nighttime combat patrol. He was serving with C Battery, 6th Battalion, 27th Artillery at the time of his death.

He was promoted posthumously to the grade of Captain as of 24 June 1966 under the provisions of Public Law 680.

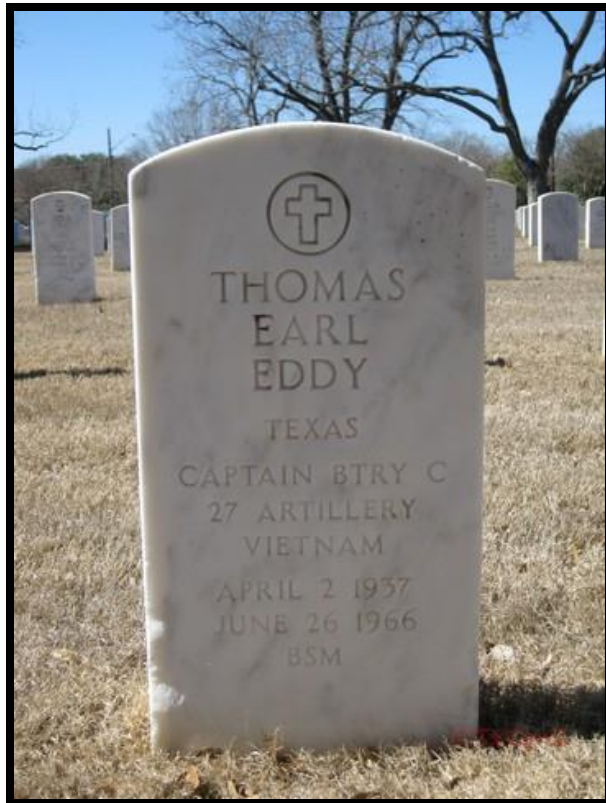
CPT Eddy served in the National Guard from January 18, 1959 to October 24, 1964. He went on active duty with 7th Battalion 8th Artillery on October 25, 1964 at Fort Bliss, Texas. He then served with the 6th Battalion, 27th Artillery at Fort Bliss beginning September 1, 1965 and arrived in Vietnam with the unit on October 5, 1965.
