I remember Mike Elledge well, although I did not know of his sacrifice for many years after. I was visiting the OCS "museum" when I first learned of his death in the early 80s. We were officer candidates in the same OCS class at Ft. Sill. His bunk was on the second floor of our barracks, and I was on the first floor, so we never became best of friends, but we spent 6 grueling months in the same unit. He was a good guy and we ran the hill many times together on weekends to work off demerits. We were commissioned on July 11, 1967, and I never saw him again. His picture is among the rest of our class which I proudly display in my home. I arrived in country more than a month after his death. To his family and friends, my sympathy, very belated, but sincere.
