

COLONEL DOUGLAS S. EVAUL CLASS 26A-67

Colonel Evaul served in Vietnam as a Liaison Officer and Platoon Leader with 2nd Battalion (Target Acquisition), 26th Artillery, Platoon Leader with 1st Battalion 44th Artillery and Commander of the 765th Security Detachment. He returned to Fort Dix and Commanded a Combat Support Training Company.

After attending Fight School and Airborne training he served as Aviation Section Commander with HHB 18th Airborne Corps Artillery at Fort Bragg. He later served with the New Jersey Army National Guard's 112th Field Artillery Group as Assistant S-2 and Light Observation Helicopter (LOH) Pilot and Commanded a Battery in the 265th Air Defense Artillery Battalion in Florida. Subsequent assignments included Assistant S-3, LNO and Command of a Battery in the 116th Field Artillery Group and Counter-fire Officer with the 227th Field Artillery Brigade. He later served as Assistant Division Air Defense Officer, S-3 and Battalion Executive of the 1st Battalion, 265th Air Defense Artillery and Commander of the 3rd Battalion, 265th Air Defense Artillery. His career culminated as the Florida State Area Command Plans, Operations and Military Support Officer.

Colonel Evaul's decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal and the Army Commendation Medal with Four Oak Leaf Clusters.
