

COLONEL CHARLES F. FELDMAYER CLASS 12-67

Colonel Feldmayer first served in a variety command and staff positions with the 2nd Battalion, 44th Artillery at Fort Sill. During a tour of duty in Vietnam he was Assistant Operations Officer, 23rd Artillery Group. While stationed in Germany he commanded the 4th USA Artillery Detachment and later served as Operations Officer, 294th Artillery Group. He then served as the Deputy Director of Resource Management at Fort Polk.

After attending the Armed Forces Staff College his next assignment was as Liaison Officer to the French Artillery School at Draguignon, France. He then commanded 2nd Battalion, 377th Artillery in Herzogenaurach, Germany. Subsequent assignments included Chief of Operations and later Chief of Staff, VII Corps Artillery. After attending the Army War College, he first served as the Deputy Director of the Army Budget for Investments and then Executive Officer, Director of the Army Budget. His last five years on active duty were spent at the Pentagon as Chief of the Congressional Budget Liaison Office where he was responsible for liaison with the House and Senate Appropriations Committee. In that position he advised the Army leadership on congressional issues and facilitated the dialogue between Congress and the Army to secure funding for service initiatives.

Colonel Feldmayer's decorations include the Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star with two Oak Leaf Clusters and the Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster.
