Graduated from OCS at Fort Sill on March 11, 1943. Assigned to the Field Artillery School at Fort Sill and attended the AAF Liaison Pilot School at Harte Flying Service, Denton, Texas where he received his basic flight training and wings. He was finishing his training at Fort Sill when he had a fatal crash at Fort Sill. The occupant of the aircraft was 2LT Herbert F. Green (FA OCS Class 54-43) and he also died in the crash.



Liaison Plane Crash Kills Two at Fort Sill

FORT SILL, July 16.—(AP)—Two field artillery fliers, killed when their "grasshopper" liaison plane crashed, were identified Friday night as Second Lieuts. Newman R. Gallagher, 23 years old, Presque Isle, Me., and Herbert F. Green jr., Amelia, Va.
