1LT Granger died in the crash of a fixed-wing aircraft from the 219th Aviation Company (Recon) while serving as an aerial observer with Headquarters, 1st Battalion, 92nd Artillery.

**Conflicting reports on the incident:**

According to the website [www.armyaircrews.com](http://www.armyaircrews.com) the aircraft (**likely an O-1 Bird Dog**) piloted by 1LT Lynnford H. Higley was involved in a mid-air collision with a U.S. Air Force F-4.

Another report indicates that the plane was brought down by hostile fire.

**He is buried at Granger Cemetery, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana**
