5. Brief resume of duty assignments:

a. Enlisted Service. Enlisted in 119 FA Regt, 19 Oct 40. Attended Enlisted Communications Course at Field Artillery School 1942.

b. Commissioned Service. Attended Field Artillery OCS, graduated 20 May 1943. Served with various FA units prior to going overseas. Assigned to 11th FA Bn, 24th Inf Div, and participated in the Philippine Islands during WW II. Commissioned a 1LT in the 119th FA Bn 15 Dec 46, and served with this unit until 15 Jun 59. Duty assignments included Btry Cdr, Bn S-- 1, Asst S-3, Bn XO and Bn CO. Assigned to 46 Inf Div Arty as S-3 from 15 Jun 59 until 3 Aug 65. Assigned as 46 Inf Div G-3 from 4 Aug 65 until 31 Jan 68. Assigned as Director, Operations/Plans & Training, HQ Michigan Army National Guard from 1 Feb 68 until the present date. Employed in the National Guard Technician program (full time) since 1 Jul 49.

Five years of active duty during WW II, and over 23 years as a full-time technician in the National Guard. All of this service has been in the FA Branch.

In addition to the above mentioned FA Courses, completed FA Branch Officer Advanced Course in 1951, and C&GSC in 1965. Attended several refresher courses at the FA School, C&GSC, and one refresher course at the USAIS.
