## Dayton Flyer Dies In Battle Action; Another Missing.

Second Lt. Gene R. Hall, 24, was killed in action in Italy Feb. 1, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Francis M. Hall of 626 Earl avenue, were informed by the war department yesterday.

Lieutenant Hall was graduated from Kiser high school in 1938 and was employed in the circulation department of the Dayton Daily News until he was drafted in 1941. He trained at Camp Shelby, Miss., Camp Bowie, Tex., and was graduated from the field artillery officers' candidate school at Ft. Sill, Okla. He received further training at Camp Gruber, Okla., before he was sent overseas early in 1943. He fought in the African campaign and was in the first invasion of Italy.
