Preserving the Legacy of Artillery Officer Candidate School Fort Sill, Oklahoma July 10, 1941 to July 7, 1973

The Artillery Officer Candidate School played a crucial part in an important chapter of America's history. That story is now presented to the public inside a new addition to the Field Artillery Museum at Fort Sill.

The Artillery OCS Heritage Hall recognizes the significant contributions of Artillery OCS to our nation. If you attended OCS, it was likely a turning point in your life. Your support ensures that our history is known and our legacy preserved. Funding and sustainment for the Heritage Hall comes entirely from graduates, cadre, families and friends of the Fort Sill Artillery Officer Candidate School.

THANK YOU to more than 800 individuals and groups who have provided financial support for the Heritage Hall project. That generous support makes this all possible.

If you have not already done so, a donation of \$250 or more will help us with sustainment. A contribution in any amount is welcomed and very much appreciated. Construction is complete and the Field Artillery Museum was granted beneficial occupancy of the building on December 12, 2023. We had a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony followed by a light lunch inside the Hall on November 2, 2024.

The Heritage Hall is a joint project of the Artillery OCS Alumni, the Artillery Museum, and Fort Sill. The 40' x 80' addition to the South Gallery of the Museum will serve as a theater/classroom with wall space dedicated to the OCS story: the history, culture, and traditions of Artillery OCS; our heroes; our fallen comrades; and distinguished graduates. There are display cases, uniform displays, OCS history panels, and photos.

Kiosks with Artillery OCS Hall of Fame Inductee photos and bios, Fallen Comrade biographical information, Class Photos and loads of OCS history will augment the displays. A $40' \times 50'$ multi-purpose courtyard graces the east entrance.

The Heritage Hall will help the U.S. Field Artillery Museum fulfill its mission and significantly increase our exposure to the public. It is secure and open during regular Museum hours. More than 28,000 visitors will have access to the Heritage Hall yearly.

On December 23, 2024 we had accrued \$970,067 for the project: \$797,505 in contributions received since November 1, 2019 and \$172,562 from our General Fund that has been temporarily restricted by the Alumni Board of Directors for the Heritage Hall Project (construction, furnishings, displays, kiosks and sustainment).

Payments to CDBL, Inc for construction management and subcontractors for work completed and materials totaled \$832,797.92 and were carried on our books as WIP (Work in Progress) an asset until May 9, 2024. That leaves us with \$136, 619 remaining on hand and available for the project in the future. The facility was inspected by Fort Sill Directorate of Public Works (DPW), and the building and contents were officially gifted to Fort Sill on May 9, 2024 after the signage was added to the front of the building to complete the project.

The gift package was prepared in accordance with Army Regulation 1-100, the Army Gift Program and presented to the Fort Sill Commanding general on July 7, 2020. The final design details (construction plans and drawings) were prepared in consultation with the Fort Sill Directorate of Public Works (DPW). The gift package was approved by the Secretary of the Army on August 4, 2022. The letter from the Secretary made it out of the Pentagon on October 21, 2022.

The entire project was reviewed and consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office in a three-phase process and no issues were found. We were fortunate to have Frank Siltman consulting with our project team. He was the Western Region Director of Museums, U.S. Army Center of Military History until retirement.





U.S. Field Artillery Museum Director/Curator Gordon Blaker worked tirelessly with our team on the exhibits, display cases, and OCS history information panels. To ensure everything is in order, we continue to coordinate our activities with the Fort Sill Museum Facility Operations Specialist Michele Mabry and the Fort Sill Directorate of Public Works (DPW).

Fort Sill DPW issued a license to our contractor in November 2022.

When the bids from sub-contractors came in during December 2022, we hit an obstacle (primarily inflation) that increased our projected cost substantially. We immediately reached out to our Alumni and Friends on December 20, 2022 for help and the response was overwhelming. The additional contributions through November 28, 2024 topped \$306,995.

Contributors to the Artillery OCS Heritage Hall project at the following levels will be recognized on two special wall panels inside the entrance and eventually on the kiosks that will soon be installed.

Panel One:

The <u>"Commandants"</u> Level (\$25,000 or more)

The <u>"Five-Star"</u> Level (\$10,000 or more)

<u>Four-Star</u>: \$5,000 -\$9,999 <u>Three-Star</u>: \$2,500 - \$4999

Panel Two:

Two-Star: \$1,000 - \$2499

The following level of recognition will be acknowledged on flip charts:

One-Star: \$500 - \$999

All contributions made in "Memory of" or "in Honor" of specific individuals are documented with the memorial wording requested by the donors for viewing. The contribution amounts are not recorded on the flip charts.

The campaign to raise money for the Heritage Hall project does not have an ending date. Funds will be required for sustainment.

If you choose to make more than one contribution during the campaign, the cumulative amount contributed will be used to determine your recognition level. Contributions "In Memory of" or "In Honor of" graduates will be shown at the appropriate recognition level and will be noted inside the Heritage Hall.

Individual Classes may wish to pool their contributions to receive special recognition at the Three-Star Level or above in the Group contributor category. Some graduates have made contributions and encouraged classmates and other alumni to contribute to this very worthwhile project. I encourage you to do the same.
