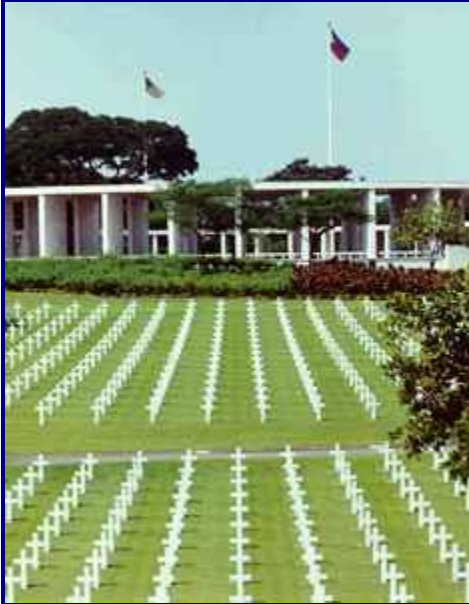

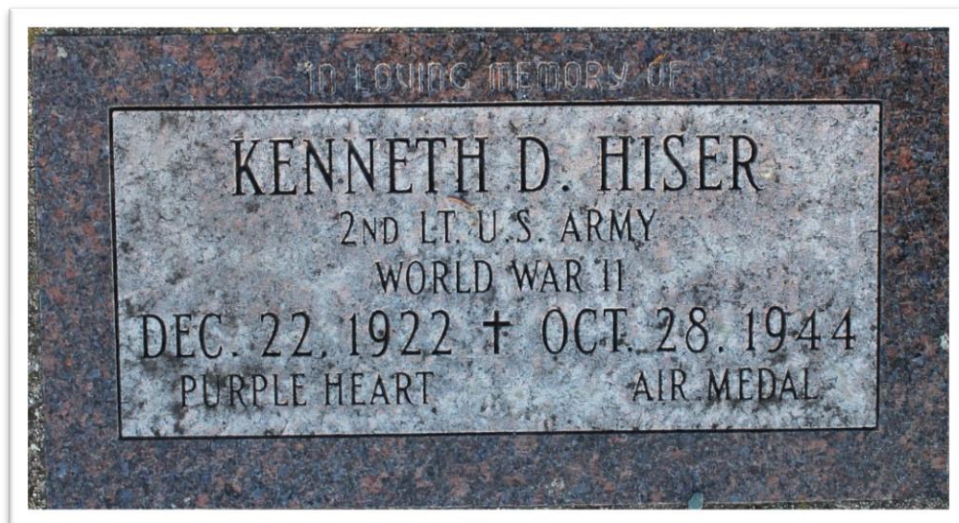


Kenneth Hiser Killed at Leyte

Mr. and Mrs. Melvin Hiser, Cerro Gordo, have received word from the War department that their son, Lieut. Kenneth D. Hiser, 23, was killed in action on Leyte, Oct. 28.

A graduate of the University of Illinois, Lieutenant Hiser was a member of the reserve officer training corps, and had been in service two years. He was liaison officer with the heavy artillery.

Besides his parents, he leaves a brother, Harold, of Decatur, and a grandmother, Mrs. Kate Mash, Cerro Gordo.
