Captain Holloway served in a variety of Field Artillery assignments including a tour in Vietnam with the 1st Battalion, 77th Field Artillery, 1st Cavalry Division. He was then assigned to the 80th Artillery Group at Fort Carson Colorado followed by service with the Wyoming Army National Guard.

Upon returning to active duty he attended the US Naval Flight School at Pensacola, Florida and was commissioned an Ensign in the United States Naval Reserve. He then attended and graduated from U.S. Naval Basic Underwater Demolition/Seal (BUDS/S) Training at Coronado. California. His subsequent assignments Underwater Demolition Team Commander, Seal Team Platoon Commander, Special Boat Unit Commander, UDT/Seal Special Warfare Plans Officer and Deputy Commander Naval Security Coordination Team. He also served in the Pentagon as Branch Chief for J-3 Special Operations Division, Combating Terrorism Branch. After Commanding Seal Team Four, he served as Chief of Staff Naval Special Warfare Group Two and later the 6th Fleet Task Group Commander. His career culminated as Chief of Staff Special Operations Command, Central, MacDill Air Force Base.

Captain Holloway's decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star (with Oak-Leaf Cluster), The Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (Four awards), the Air Medal, the Joint Service Commendation Medal and the Army Commendation Medal (with V-Device).
