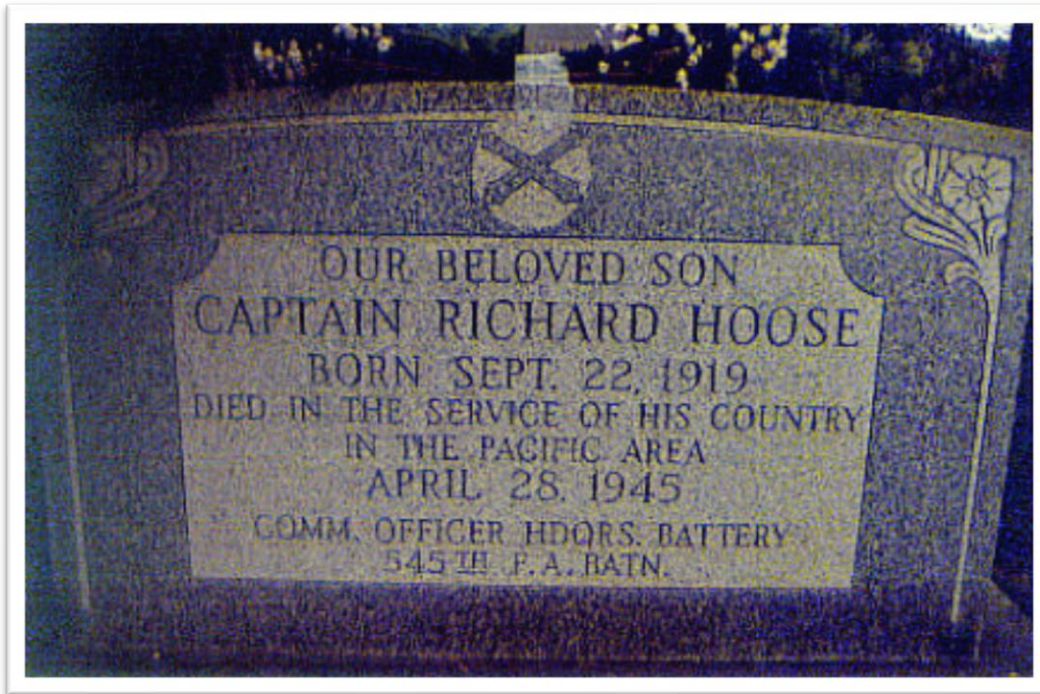


**Communications Officer with Headquarters Battery, 545th Field Artillery Battalion**

Captain Hoose was head of a field artillery unit which had been practising difficult maneuvers utilizing howitzers and other heavy pieces of artillery when he last wrote home from the Hawaiian islands. His base had been changed to another inland just a few weeks before he was killed. The captain was last home on Thanksgiving. He was a graduate of Central high school and attended Akron university, where he was a member of the R.O.T.C. He leaves besides his parents, two sisters, Dorothy, and Mrs. Leola Painter. He went to Hawaii last January.
