1LT Inman was assigned to the 48th Assault Helicopter Company, 1st Aviation Brigade. The UH-1H Helicopter that he was flying was shot down in a landing zone. Although 1LT Inman and the other crew members were able to escape the downed aircraft, he was killed by enemy small arms fire as he crawled away from the wreckage.
