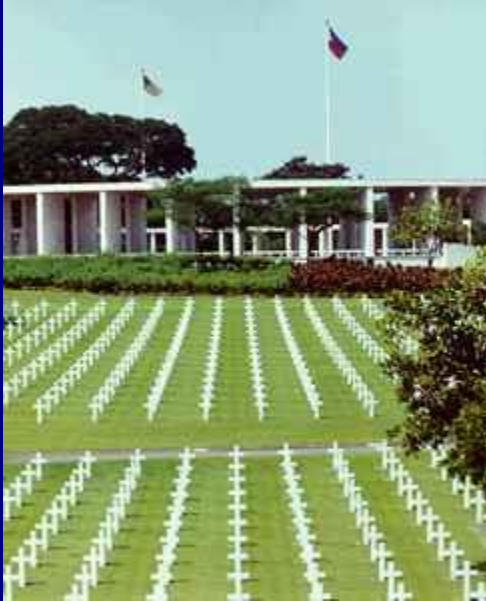

1LT Johnston was killed in an air crash at Hollandia, New Guinea. He was serving as a reconnaissance officer at the time of his death, was in training as an artillery spotter. It is believed that he was killed while on a training flight. He went overseas in April 1944. He was a member of the 109th Tennessee National Guard and when the guard unit was activated, he became a member of a field artillery unit and later attended Officer Candidate School at Fort Sill.
