Brief resume of duty assignments: Commands the 108th Military Intelligence Group engaged in operational activities within the states of New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont and Rhode Island, covering an area of approximately 124,000 square miles with a population of approximately 35,000,000. Operationally directs and guides staff at Group level and subordinate Regions. Maintains liaison with delimitations agreement signatories. Supervises administrative procedures, care and utilization of Government-issue equipment and emergency planning procedures.

7. General Remarks: Upon graduation from Officer Candidate Course, I was assigned as a Battery Executive Officer to an Artillery unit and, within four months, I assumed command of the battery. I commanded B Btry, 172d FA Bn, during five campaigns in Europe. At the end of World War II, I assumed command of the battalion and held this position until I rotated to the United States during the latter part of 1945. I received a terminal promotion to the rank of Major on 3 January 1946 and for the next three years attended college in an inactive status. I was recalled to active duty 1 April 1949 and have served since that date continuously in military intelligence.
