Research has not determined if the Silver Star award cited above is for William A. Jones (ASN: O-1177476), since it is not known which unit he served in or the date of death. In addition, there are at least six individuals with the same name killed in World War II and certainly many more with the same name who served and might have been the lone recipient of the above-mentioned award.

A citation is needed to help tell the story of his heroic actions and to perpetuate the memory of his wartime service and sacrifice.
