Colonel Krebs served 32 years in the U.S. Army in a variety of Command and Staff assignments to include four years on the Army Staff in the Pentagon. Overseas tours included duty in Korea, Germany, Greece, and Vietnam, where he served with Military Assistance Command Vietnam (MACV).

His initial assignment after graduating from Officer Candidate School was with Battery B, 158th Field Artillery, 45th Infantry Division, Korea. He later commanded Battery C, 1st Battalion, 22nd Artillery in Germany, the 18th USA Missile Detachment in Greece and the 2nd Training Battalion U.S. Army Training Center, Fort Sill. He graduated from the U.S Army War College, the U.S. Naval War College, U.S Army Command and General Staff College and the U.S. Army Language School. His career culminated as the Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff, U.S. Army TRADOC Combat Development.

Following retirement, he was employed by Cubic Applications Incorporated in support of the Joint Warfighting Center in Suffolk, Virginia.

Colonel Krebs' decorations include the Legion of Merit with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Joint Service Commendation Medal and the Army Commendation Medal.
