

Colonel J D Leverett Class 8-67

Colonel Leverett's initial assignment was Executive Officer, Battery D 6th Battalion, 65th Artillery, Key West, Florida. During a tour in Vietnam he served as Assistant Platoon Leader Battery D, 5th Battalion, 2nd Artillery and later as Chief, Mobile Advisory Team 34, Military Assistance Command Vietnam (MACV).

At Fort Bliss, he Commanded HHB, 4th Battalion, 56th Artillery and served as Ordnance Guided Missile Staff Officer, 8th Battalion 15th Artillery. He was later stationed in Korea as Commander, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 44th Artillery. He returned to the States and served as Operations Officer for the Amarillo District Recruiting Command.

He then served with 2nd Battalion, 2nd Air Defense Artillery in Germany as the S-3 and later Battalion XO. His next assignment was Deputy G-3, Command and Control, Headquarters, 32nd Army Air Defense Command (AADCOM). Subsequent assignments included service as Chief of Logistic Management Division of the HELLFIRE/GLD (Ground Laser Designators) Project Office at Redstone Arsenal and duty at the Pentagon with the Department of the Inspector General. He then served as Commander, 2nd Battalion, 2nd Air Defense Artillery in Germany and returned to the Pentagon as the Chief, Resource Priority Team in the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations.

Colonel Leverett culminated his career as Deputy Director, Resource Management, Headquarters, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. His decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, the Army Commendation Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters and the Combat Infantryman Badge.
