Colonel Eddie W. Liles was born in Glynn County, Georgia. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant, Field Artillery through Officer Candidate School in December 1967 and subsequently has served for more than 26 years as an officer in the United States Army and Army Reserve. Colonel Liles began his military career on active duty at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and later served in numerous duty locations.

While on active duty Colonel Liles served in the following positions:

After leaving active duty in 1980, Colonel Liles entered the United States Army Reserve in 1984 and joined the 4155th USARF School in 1986, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, serving as a Field Artillery Advance Course Instructor. In 1991, he became the Assistant Operations Officer and in 1992 became the Operations Officer for the school. In 1995, he became the Assistant Operations Officer for the 95th Division (IT). Later that same year he was selected to serve as the Director of the Drill Sergeant School. In 1997, he became the Deputy Chief of Staff Operations.

Colonel Liles is a graduate of the Field Artillery Officer Candidate School, Advance Course, and Command and General Staff College. Among his awards are the Bronze Star medal with two oak leaf clusters, Meritorious Service medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Army Commendation Medal and the Army Achievement medal.

Colonel Liles holds a BS in business from the University of Nebraska at Omaha. He is currently employed as the Deputy Director of Combat Developments Fort Sill, Oklahoma. His wife Dana is a school teacher in the Altus Public School System. They have five children.
