Colonel Lorenz's initial assignment after Officer Candidate School was with Headquarters Battery, 4th Division Artillery at Yakima Firing Center, Fort Lewis Washington.

He then served in a variety of Staff and Command positions with the 2nd Battalion, 104th Regiment, 104th Division (Training) United States Army Reserve in Washington State. Assignments included Field Artillery Platoon Leader, Battery Commander and Engineer Company Commander. He later served as the Regimental S-1, followed by duty with the 3rd Battalion, 104th Regiment as the Battalion Executive Officer, Battalion S-2, Battalion S-3 and finally as the Battalion Commander.

Subsequent assignments included command of the 1st Battalion, 3rd Brigade, 104th Division and Brigade Commander, 4th Brigade, 104th Division. He later served as the Deputy Chief of Staff, Operations, Intelligence and Training, 124th ARCOM and Commandant, 6236th United States Army Reserve School, Tacoma Washington. His career culminated as the Mobilization Designee, ARPCN Mobilization Preassignment Branch, Fort Meyer, Virginia. In civilian life he spent 41 years with the Boeing Company, to include 38 years in management in the Defense and Space Division, Commercial Airplane Division, Computing Support Division and finally the Boeing Support Systems Division.

Colonel Lorenz's decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters.
