Burial services for Lt. Edward E. Ludwig Jr. were held today at the Union Dale Cemetery.




Lt. Ludwig, liaison pilot for the Field Artillery, was killed in a plane accident over Germany Jan. 4. 1946. He had served with the First Infantry Division from December, 1944, until signing of the peace and was with the Army of Oc-

He was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. Ed Ludwig of 514 S. Linden Ave. to be killed in service. The other was Flight Officer William E., co-pilot of a Liberator bomber, who was killed in action Dec. 19, 1944.

Lt. Ludwig was a graduate of Cornell University, a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity and the Third United Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are his widow, Jane Fitzpatrick Ludwig; his parents, and a brother, James B. Ludwig.
