

COLONEL MICHAEL T. METCALF CLASS 30A-67

Colonel Metcalf was a distinguished graduate of the Artillery Officer Candidate School. He was initially assigned to Battery F, 25th Artillery (Searchlight) at Fort Carson, Colorado as a platoon leader He then served a tour of duty in Vietnam as a Platoon Commander with Battery B, 29th Artillery (Searchlight).

Following active duty, he joined the US Army Reserve and branch transferred to the Engineers and joined the 397th Engineer Battalion in Eau Clair, Wisconsin. He served in almost every staff and command position in the battalion including Communications Officer, Recon Officer, Engineer Equipment Officer, Company Commander, S-1 Assistant S-3, S-3, S-4, Battalion Executive Officer and Battalion Commander.

He later served as 372nd Engineer Group Executive Officer in Des Moines, Iowa followed by an assignment as the Assistant Deputy Director of the US Army Corps of Engineers where he reviewed and made recommendations on projects submitted by the Corps of Engineers Divisions across the country.

He retired from Verizon Communications as a Vice President of Human Resources and has been instrumental in organizing Honor Flights for veterans from Wisconsin and supporting deployed soldiers and families in the Madison, Wisconsin area.

Colonel Meyer's decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, and the Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters.
