KILLED IN BELGIUM

Lieutenant Edward A. Mitchell, Jr., 23, of 140 North Hager avenue, Barrington, was killed in action in Belgium on January 14. The lieutenant entered France on D-day June 6, and his various exploits include participation in the parachute attack in Holland. He received a presidential citation for his deeds and on June 30, 1944, was promoted to first lieutenant. He took part in the recent big drive with the 101st Division near Bastogne, Belgium. last messages from the soldier are two letters written January 8.
