

COLONEL GREGORY V. MORTON CLASS 13-70

Colonel Morton served with the 4th Battalion, 3rd Artillery at Fort Sill as Adjutant and a Battery Executive Officer, prior to serving as an Aide De Camp at Fort Hood, Texas.

He spent two years as a reservist before returning to the Active Duty Force. He then commanded a detachment of the 507th Artillery and served as Assistant S-3 of the 5th USA Artillery Group in Germany. He then commanded a Battery and served as S-3 with the 3rd Battalion, 21st Artillery at Fort Polk. After attending the USA Organizational Effectiveness School he served as a staff officer with Readiness Group Stewart at Newburgh Sub-Post, West Point New York. Subsequent assignments included Inspector General Headquarters USA Europe and Seventh Army, Executive Officer of 1st Battalion, 12th Field Artillery, Executive Officer of the 75th Field Artillery Brigade and Commander of 5th Battalion, 18th Field Artillery at Fort Sill. He then served as the Field Artillery Enlisted Branch Chief followed by attendance at the National War College. His career culminated as the Deputy J-1 US Central Command at MacDill Air Force Base.

Colonel Morton's decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal and the Kuwait Liberation Medal.
