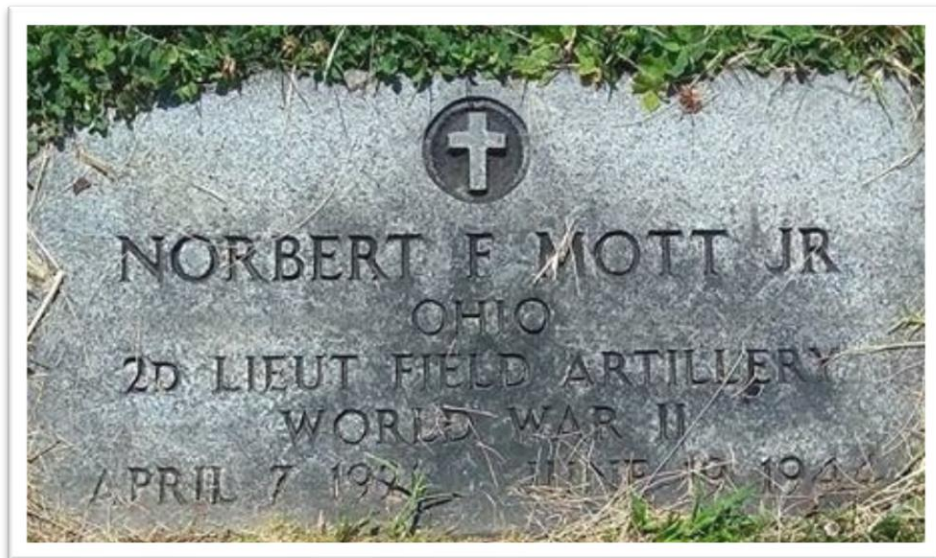


Died of wounds received on May 28, 1944 serving with Battery B

Second Lt. Norbert F. Mott Jr.,
23, son of Mr. and Mrs. Norbert
F. Mott, 5866 Redbank Rd., who
was wounded on the road to Rome
May 28 but who was thought to be
recovering, died June 19, his par-
ents have been advised. He was
serving as a forward observer for
the field artillery when wounded.
A graduate of Xavier University,
Lieutenant Mott had been in the
service since February, 1943. Be-
sides his parents, he is survived by
three brothers, Pfc. Henry Mott,
Camp Jackson, N. C., and Ralph
and James Mott, both at home.
