5. BRIEF RESUME OF DUTY ASSIGNMENTS:


Served on AD from 3 March 1941 thru 27 Jan 1946 with duties of Commo Off, Plat Ldr and Btry Cmd. His National Guard service began with the Utah NG 5 Dec 1934 until he entered active duty. He served in the Utah and Indiana NG following WWII prior to appointment in the Florida NG 2 Jan 54. He served therein until retirement 6 Mar 1972. His assignments included Asst G-2, G-3 and Chief of Staff - Division. Was serving as Task Force Commander at time of retirement.
