**Second Lieutenant Murphy was a forward observer with the 48th Field Artillery Battalion, 7th Infantry Division. On October 15, 1952 near Song Jong, North Korea, he left a relatively safe position so that he could see the enemy forces and direct artillery fire on them and was killed by enemy fire.**
